

National Grid would like to update you on our plans for Sea Link following our non-statutory consultation last year.

Since our informal (non-statutory) consultation closed at the end of 2022, we have been continuing to develop the project from an indicative 'graduated swathe' into a more refined design.

This process is informed by considering feedback received during public consultation alongside input from statutory stakeholders, the outcomes of various environmental and engineering surveys, and ongoing engineering and design development.

We will present the detail of our refined proposals, and seek further feedback, during a formal (statutory) consultation,


that we plan to hold for eight-weeks between October and December 2023.

In the meantime, we are holding targeted conversations with local authorities and other statutory consultees, and we continue to engage with landowners to discuss access for surveys.
