



MINSTER CEMETERY & GARDEN OF REST TERMS & CONDITIONS

Graves/Plots

- With the exception of floral decorations, temporary number stones, and approved receptacles for containing water, nothing movable shall be placed on any plot without consent of the Council.
- Any item, plant or object placed on any plot becomes the property of the Council
- Planting on any plot is not permitted as Minster Cemetery is a lawn burial ground.
- One vase of metal or stone may be placed on the plot for a period of six months following the most recent interment.
- Floral decorations may be placed on any plot.
- All dead flowers, wreaths, weeds, rubbish and other decoration which have become unsightly shall be removed from plots and disposed of.

Memorial/Headstones

- A memorial permit must be obtained from Minster Parish Council prior to erection of any memorial.
- All memorials shall be of natural stone or other approved materials
- Must be erected by a memorial mason approved by the council.
- Headstones must not exceed 5ft in height on burial plots
- Headstones must not exceed 2ft 6" in height on Garden of Rest plots
- Must be kept tidy and in good repair by the owner of the Deed of Grant.

Cemetery

- Dogs on leads are permitted in the cemetery.
- No memorial benches shall be placed at the cemetery.
- Any change of address by the owner of the Deed of Grant should be notified to the Clerk of Minster Parish Council
- No instruments of music, flags or banners are to be taken into the cemetery without special permission, except for Military or Salvation Army funerals.
